Reporting to the Manager of Diagnostic Services, the incumbent plans organizes and supervises the activities of the Diagnostic Imaging Department within the context of the Vision and Mission Statement of the Hay River Health and Social Services Authority (HRHSSA), and the departmental budget, and in accordance with the National Standards and the Administrative policies.

The incumbent ensures the provision of Radiography, Mammography and Ultrasound Imaging Services, with adherence to the Codes of Ethics and Standards of Practice of the CAMRT (Canadian Association of Medical Radiation Technologists), NWT Breast Health Advisory Committee and the ARDMS (American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers) as well as in accordance with the HRHSSA policies and procedures of the Diagnostic Imaging department.

The incumbent ensures that the department produces good quality images, upon referral from the Medical staff, in a safe and efficient manner to aid the local physicians and the **off-site** Radiologist to obtain a timely diagnosis and treatment for all clients of the HRHSSA.
